

RABQSA Launches Bus Operator Accreditation Auditor Scheme

Sydney, Australia: RABQSA International is officially launching the Bus Operator Accreditation Auditor Scheme. The **Bus Operator Accreditation Scheme (BOAS) Auditor Certification Scheme** has been developed by RABQSA International, Inc in conjunction with the NSW Ministry of Transport (MoT).

Representatives from MoT, NSW Roads and Transport Authority (RTA), Independent Transport Safety and Reliability Regulator, and the Bus and Coach Association formed the RABQSA Sub-Scheme Committee (SSC) that oversees the development and management of the Scheme.

The Scheme will provide recognition for auditors who conduct audits on behalf of the MoT to ensure that bus operators can demonstrate that they are meeting the requirements of the Bus Operators Accreditation Scheme (BOAS), as defined by the MoT.

“The ability to develop an industry-based certification scheme with government, regulators and private industry, shows the growing acceptance of competency-based certification and how it can easily integrated into current regulatory systems, stated Peter Holtmann, Director Business Development and Marketing, RABQSA. “This is a win-win for auditor recognition and industry confidence”, he added.

The BOAS Auditor Scheme has incorporated, competency-based certification requirements using the ISO/IEC 17024:2003 standard. Auditors certified by RABQSA will be listed on the RABQSA international register of certified.
