The Generic Training Course Certification (GTCC) Development and Delivery Requirements were created in response to the growing needs of the industry to have their broad range of training courses RABQSA certified.

This scheme establishes general requirements focusing on design and development of training courses to international best practice, regardless of subject matter. The scheme can be used independent of RABQSA personnel certification requirements and allows for exclusive international certification of training courses. Training Providers can use the requirements to certify a course or a suite/program of courses.

"We are pleased to be able to provide an option to training providers for recognition of training that might normally not receive independent verification," commented Shanya Salamaca, Director Certification Services, RABQSA.

Under RABQSA GTCC Training Provider Administration Requirements, RABQSA will evaluate a training course/program for conformity, which includes the training provider's administrative management system, and course content and structure. The content and structure are reviewed for course analysis, design, development and delivery method.

"Training Providers can use this scheme to demonstrate to their customers that an accredited international body has evaluated their processes and have deemed them to meet a specific set of best practice requirements," said Ms Salamaca. "Training courses that have never been able to achieve external recognition now have that option."
